- Identifying hazards, assessing risks, implementing appropriate controls, and reviewing their effectiveness.
- Providing personnel and visitors with information, instruction, training, and supervision appropriate to the hazards they are likely to encounter.
- Seeking participation of our personnel in dealing with safety and health matters and
- Assessing our activities through frequent audits and reviews to continuously improve the performance of our management systems and overall safety culture.
